

Ellen MacArthur Foundation Terms of Use

Ellen MacArthur Foundation (**we** or **EMF**) is a charitable company, limited by guarantee, with company number 06897785 and charity number 1130306.

These terms (**Terms of Use**) govern your participation in webinars run or hosted by EMF (**Webinars**) and your use of all resources provided or made available to you by EMF, whether made available online, by email or by any other method of communication and in any format (**Resources**).

In these Terms of Use, any reference to **you** denotes the entity entering into these terms, which may be an individual or an organisation.

1. Access to the Webinars and the Resources

1.1. The Webinars and the Resources have been created by or on behalf of EMF. Access to the Webinars and the Resources is at our discretion. We may change the date and time of the Webinars at any time and we may revoke your access to the Webinars and the Resources on immediate written notice.

2. Ownership and use of the Resources

2.1. All Resources are owned by or licensed to EMF.

2.2. Nothing in these Terms of Use transfers any rights or grants any interest in the intellectual property in the Resources to you or to any third party, except as expressly set out in the limited licence contained in clause 2.3 below.

2.3. When EMF provides you with the Resources, it grants to you a non-transferable, non-sublicensable, non-exclusive, royalty free and revocable licence to use the Resources:

- a) solely to facilitate and develop your understanding of the circular economy; and
- b) in accordance with any documentation or instructions given to you by EMF.

2.4. EMF may terminate the licence granted to you in clause 2.3 on immediate written notice. In the event of such termination, you must return or destroy all copies of the Resources, at EMF's election.

2.5. Without limiting the generality of clause 2.3, you will not:

- a) share or licence the Resources or any content contained within the Resources with or to anyone (except where that content has otherwise been made publicly available by EMF or is a third party resource featured in the Resources which is made publicly available by that third party);
- b) edit or adapt the Resources in any way;
- c) use the Resources for any illegal purpose or in breach of any applicable laws and regulations;
- d) sell, or otherwise commercially exploit, the Resources or use them for profit or commercial gain or for your own marketing or promotional purposes;
- e) represent yourself as being employed by EMF (or similar) or hold yourself out as being in partnership or otherwise associated with EMF; or
- f) use the name or any logo of EMF (except where express permission has otherwise been granted to you by EMF).

2.6. You agree that you will not access the Webinars or use the Resources in such a way as may bring EMF into disrepute.

3. Ownership and use of Your Materials and Your Contribution

- 3.1. If you participate in a Webinar, you may choose to present materials (**Your Materials**). If you do so:
- a) you confirm that: (i) Your Materials are either owned by or licensed to you; (ii) if Your Materials are licensed to you, you are entitled to grant the licence contemplated in clause 3.1(b); and (iii) you are entitled to give the consent to EMF making the Recording contemplated in clause 4.1; and
 - b) you hereby grant to EMF a perpetual, non-exclusive, sublicensable, royalty-free, worldwide licence to: (i) use Your Materials; and (ii) edit or modify Your Materials, in each case for purposes consistent with our charitable objectives, and provided that EMF will not distort Your Materials in a way that will (i) materially change their substance or meaning; or (ii) depict you in a way that is disparaging or offensive.
- 3.2. You may submit a contribution to EMF which may be included in the Resources or, if you use the Resources, you may choose to contribute to them or provide feedback in relation to them to EMF (**Your Contribution**). If you do so:
- a) you confirm that: (i) you are entitled to give Your Contribution; and (ii) if Your Contribution is licensed to you, you are entitled to grant the licence contemplated in clause 3.3; and
 - b) subject to clause 3.3, you agree that EMF will own Your Contribution, and that EMF may use Your Contribution for purposes consistent with its charitable objectives, including but not limited to incorporating it into its own materials and making it available to any third party, without compensation to you.
- 3.3. If Your Contribution includes an image, name or logo (**Image**), you hereby grant to EMF a perpetual, non-exclusive, sublicensable, royalty-free, worldwide licence to: (i) use the Image; and (ii) edit or modify the Image, in each case for purposes consistent with our charitable objectives, and provided that EMF will not distort the Image in a way that will (i) materially change its substance or meaning; or (ii) depict you in a way that is disparaging or offensive.

4. Recording your participation

- 4.1. If you participate in a Webinar, EMF may capture your participation and Your Materials in audio and/or video format (**Recording**). You hereby consent to EMF making the Recording (and if consenting on behalf of an individual, confirm that you have authority to consent on behalf of that individual) and agree that EMF owns the intellectual property rights in the Recording and may use the Recording for purposes consistent with its charitable objectives, including but not limited to sharing the Recording with other participants in the Webinars and making the Recording available on EMF's website and social media channels.

5. Confidentiality

- 5.1. If the Webinar in which you are participating is being hosted as a workshop or working group, confidential information may be shared by participants in the Webinar. Confidential information is any information that a reasonable person would consider is, by implication, confidential or commercially sensitive. You agree that you will not use, share, discuss or otherwise disclose any confidential information from the Webinar outside of the Webinar (other than to the extent required by law or any legal or regulatory authority).

6. Disclaimers and warranties

- 6.1. You acknowledge that the Webinars and the Resources are provided 'as is'. EMF makes no representations and provides no warranties to any party in relation to any of the content of the Webinars or the Resources including as to their quality, accuracy, completeness or fitness for purpose. You are solely responsible for your participation in the Webinars and your use of the Resources and for determining whether they meet your requirements, comply with any laws or regulations applicable to you and comply with any obligations you have to third parties.
- 6.2. You acknowledge that certain information or material contained in the Webinars or the Resources may have been obtained from or produced or contributed by third parties and that any such information or material has not been verified by EMF. You agree that EMF has no responsibility

to you or to any third party for or in relation to the nature, content or use of that information or material.

- 6.3. You are responsible for configuring your information technology, computer programmes and platform to access the Webinars or the Resources. You warrant that you will not introduce any viruses or material that is technologically harmful, or otherwise impede the functioning or the integrity of the Webinars or the Resources.
- 6.4. 7. Data protection

- 7.1. If you participate in a Webinar, EMF may collect, retain and process the personal data you have provided in connection with the Webinars for the purpose of registering your interest in, and otherwise managing your relationship with EMF in respect of, the Webinars. If other participants in the Webinar can view your name and/or your image, your name and/or your image will be made available to those other participants, and EMF may collect, retain and process your name and/or image for the purpose of making the Recording and using the Recording in accordance with clause 4.1.
- 7.2. If you use Resources or provide Your Contribution in such a way that requires you to submit personal data, EMF may collect, retain and process the personal data you have provided in connection with the Resources or Your Contribution for the purpose of documenting, editing and sharing Your Contribution in accordance with clause 3, and communicating with you in respect of, your use of the Resources or Your Contribution.
- 7.3. If you sign up to receive EMF's newsletter, EMF will collect, retain and process your personal data for the purpose of sending you the newsletter.

8. General

- 8.1. These Terms of Use constitute the entire agreement between you and EMF relating to the subject matter of the Webinars and the Resources, and replace any prior agreements, oral or written, between you and EMF.
- 8.2. A person who is not a party to these Terms of Use has no rights under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999, as amended, or otherwise.
- 8.3. No variation of these Terms of Use shall be effective unless in writing and signed on behalf of EMF.

- 8.4. EMF's failure to exercise any legal right or remedy or enforce any term, either of these Terms of Use or which EMF has the benefit of under any applicable law, will not constitute a waiver of such right, remedy, or provision.
- 8.5. In the event that any of these Terms of Use is found by a court or other tribunal of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable, such provisions shall be limited or eliminated to the minimum extent necessary so that the other terms remain in full force and effect.
- 8.6. You may not assign or transfer any rights or obligations under these Terms of Use, and any such attempted assignment or transfer shall be void and without effect. EMF may freely assign or transfer all rights and obligations under these Terms of Use, in whole or in part.
- 8.7. These Terms of Use and the relationship between you and EMF shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with, English law and the parties hereto submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts.
